My Brother W<sup>m</sup> Mott & his Wife, both died at New York in

Mary, about 4 Years old is with me, whom we have kept about  
2 Years. all hearty & well. There has been no remittances  
made to the Creditors one W<sup>m</sup> Doughty was the Administrator  
to my brother W<sup>m</sup>'s Effects. and by what I can learn. There  
was full sufficient to pay everyone 20s in the pound and  
a few hundreds to spare, provided the Children can have  
Justice done them

Transcript of note by Isaac Mott, inscribed on back:

Birmingham  
26 March 1798

My brother William Mott and his wife both died at New York in North America near three years since.

William, his eldest son, is now at New York and was hearty and well 5 months since. Julius and Patty are with my brother Robert Mott at Denton near New Haven in Sussex. Jemima and Samuel at present are with Mr. Sherwood of this town. The youngest, a girl named Mary, about 4 years old is with me, whom we have kept above 2 years - all hearty and well.

There has been no remittance made to the creditors. One Mr. Doughty was the Administrator to my brother William's effects and by what I can learn there was full sufficient to pay everyone 20/ in the pound and a few hundreds to spare, provided the children can have justice done them.
